School Uniform

Thank you for helping us to maintain our high standards of school uniform. The school uniform policy is on the school website so that you can check that your child has the correct items, and has recently been reviewed by governors . The amendments are not changes but are for clarification purposes, for example, school shoes must be leather look and polishable material and do not include boots. Earrings are not permitted in our school and the policy has been updated to include clear earrings. A new addition is the section on hair bands (blue, white or hair coloured) so that the messages we give in school can be reinforced by you at home. Staff have been speaking to parents and children since the start of term, where there are a few discrepancies with any aspect of uniform, and will continue to do so on an individual basis. Similarly, do speak to your child's teacher if you need any support. We are really happy with the standard of uniform across the school and appreciate your ongoing support.
